- 1) Urgency granted.
- 2) The petition was disposed of on 27.10.2021, whereby the interim order was converted into protective bail for ten days to enable the petitioner, Saeed Khan Nizamani, to surrender before the Accountability Court, Sukkur, failing which the bail bond was to stand forfeited automatically.

Learned counsel for the applicant/surety submitted that pursuant to the earlier order dated 24.09.2019, the applicant had furnished surety by depositing a solvency certificate amounting to Rs. 500,000/- with the Nazir of this Court. It was further submitted that the petitioner subsequently surrendered before the learned III Accountability Court, Sukkur, and his bail application was disposed of vide order dated 01.11.2022; therefore, the surety was no longer required.

In the circumstances of the case, prima facie, the petitioner had duly complied with the order dated 27.10.2021 by surrendering before the learned III Accountability Court, Sukkur, within the stipulated period, the very object and purpose of the protective bail stood achieved. Consequently, no violation of the terms of the protective bail order survived, nor did any occasion arise for forfeiture of the surety bond furnished by the applicant.

It is an admitted position that the bail proceedings before the Accountability Court were subsequently concluded vide order dated 01.11.2022; therefore, the surety deposited before this Court ceased to have any legal utility or continuing obligation. Retention of the solvency certificate thereafter would serve no lawful purpose and would unnecessarily prejudice the surety, who had fulfilled his undertaking in accordance with the law.

Accordingly, as the liability of the surety stood fully discharged upon compliance with the Court's directions by the petitioner, the applicant became entitled to the release and return of the surety documents. The Nazir is, therefore, directed to return the solvency certificate to the applicant/surety after due verification and identification in accordance with the law.

The listed application stands disposed of in the above terms.
