Learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in Crime No.183 of 2015, registered at Police Station Sanghar, under section 302, 324, 395, 337-H(ii), 427, 120-B, 114, 147, 148, 149 PPC read with 6/7 ATA. According to learned counsel the name of the present applicant/accused has been mentioned in the F.I.R. i.e. Naveed alias Lundi s/o Ismail Fakir whereas, the actual name of the applicant is Mohammad Naveed s/o Mohammad Ismail. Per learned counsel the applicant did not know about registration of aforesaid F.I.R. or pendency of the case before Anti Terrorism Court who has recently come to know about such F.I.R. as the police has raided his house. Per learned counsel the applicant is willing to surrender before the trial court provided protective bail is granted to the applicant.

Without touching merits of the case, in order to enable the Applicant to appear and surrender before the trial Court, the Applicant is admitted to protective bail for seven (07) days from today subject to furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.50,000/-(Fifty thousand) and P.R. bond in the like sum to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court.

In case the Applicant fails to surrender before the trial Court within the time specified, surety furnished before this Court shall stand forfeited.

This bail shall remain effective up to 20.06.2017 or when the applicant surrender before the trial Court whichever is the earlier.

This criminal bail application stands disposed of.
