Aftab Ahmed Gorar, J- Through instant Criminal Revision Application, the applicants / accused have impugned the judgment dated 17.12.2016 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge Ubauro in Criminal Appeal No.19 of 2015 "*Re- Rajib ali and others vs. The State*", whereby the conviction and sentences awarded to the applicants / accused have been modified to the extent of *Daman* and *Arsh* amount and directed the applicants to deposit the same within a week, in case of failure to deposit the same by the applicants / accused, the amount will be recovered as arrears of Land Revenue and they may be detained in jail till the payment of *Daman* and *Arsh* amount.

2. Learned counsel for the applicants / accused after arguing the matter at some length, submits that the applicants / accused will be satisfied and not press instant Criminal Revision Application, if the *Daman* and *Arsh* amount is reduced to some extent. Such proposal of the learned counsel for the applicants is not opposed by learned Deputy Prosecutor General appearing for the State.

3. In view of the above, the instant Criminal Revision Application is dismissed as not pressed with the modification in the impugned judgment dated 17.12.2016 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge Ubauro to the extent of punishment for depositing the *Daman* and *Arsh* amount that applicants Rajib and Shoukat shall deposit an amount of Rs.50,000/- each, the applicants Wajid Ali and Yar Muhammad shall deposit the amount of Rs.20,000/- each, whereas, applicant Khair Muhammad shall also deposit an amount of Rs.25,000/- with the Additional Registrar of this Court within three days to be paid to the injured persons, respectively, in terms of the judgment dated 13.11.2015 passed by learned Assistant Sessions Judge Ubauro.
