This constitutional petition has been filed with the following prayer:

- A) To direct the respondents to issue the allotment Order of plot bearing No.90, Block 31-A, Category R of 120, Sq. Yds, Shah Latif Town, Karachi to the petitioner, as per his allotment and paid amount to the respondents.
- B) To Declare that the malafide act of official respondent against the plot of petitioner bearing plot No.90, Block 31-A, 120 Sq. Yds, Category R, Shah Latif Town, Karachi is null, vide and having no legal effects.
- C) To restrain the respondents their agents, labour, representatives or any persons not to allot the petitioner's plot to any of their choice person till the disposal of the petition.
- D) Any other relief(s), which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper under the circumstances of the case.
- *E)* Award cost of the petition.

Briefly stated the facts of the case are that the petitioner was allotted a plot bearing No.90, Block No.31-A, Category R of 120 Sq. Yds., in Shah Latif Town, through balloting for a sum of Rs.6000/-. However, due to certain internal arrangements of the respondents No.2 & 3, the petitioner was offered another plot bearing No.R-225, Block 31-D, Shah Latif Town, Karachi, in lieu of the above referred plot allotted to him.

Counsel for the petitioner states that he would be satisfied and would not press this petition, if directions are issued to the respondents No.2 & 3 to hand over the possession of the newly allotted plot to the petitioner. Counsel for the respondents No.2 & 3 states that if the petitioner approaches them, they would have no objection to hand over the possession of the said plot to the petitioner in accordance with law. The respondents No.2 & 3 thus are directed to hand over the possession of the said plot to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms alongwith the listed application.
