Instant petition has been filed on the ground that petitioners are seeking promotion on the basis of length of their services. Record reveals that representations were filed by the petitioners before DIG, T&T Sindh, Karachi, which were decided on 02.12.2019 in the following manner :-

***“Therefore, the appeal of the appellants is hereby filed on the grounds that no police personnel of Telecomm: Sindh junior to the petitioners have been promoted to the higher rank. As and when the vacancies demanded in SNE be allocated, the grievances of all deserving cases including petitioners shall be redressed accordingly and all the cases including the petitioners shall be considered for promotion as per their seniority/merit.”***

Counsel for the petitioners states that he would be satisfied and would not press the instant petition if directions are issued that DPC may be convened within six months from today and the persons qualifying for promotion may be considered, keeping in view their length of service and other relevant factors in accordance with law.

Learned Assistant Advocate General Sindh has no objection for disposal of instant petition on the said prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners.

Instant petition therefore stands disposed of in the above terms, however, it is expected that DPC would be convened within six months from today and those employees who deserve for promotion on seniority-cum-fitness basis, subject to availability of seats, may be considered for promotion, in accordance with law.
