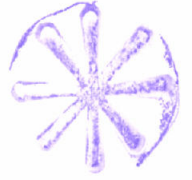

1. Urgency application granted.

2 to 4: The instant petition has been filed on the ground that illegal constructions are being raised on two separate properties, bearing House No.2-J, 3/5, known as "Siraj Homes" and House No.2E, 1/4 known as "Bismillah Arcade", situated at Inquiry Office, Nazimabad No.2, Liaquatabad Town, Karachi.

At the very outset, the counsel appearing in the instant matter has been asked as to the identity of the persons/owners/builders who are allegedly raising illegal constructions on the said properties as there is no mention in the petition in that regard. No answer to this question was forthcoming on the part of counsel appearing for the petitioner. He was then asked as to how a single writ petition could be maintained against distinct properties, especially when the separate persons/owners/builders were also not identified in the petition, to which again the counsel appearing for the petitioner has given no explanation,





except saying that illegal constructions is being carried out on the above referred properties.

Be that as it may even if, for the arguments' sake, it is assumed that such illegal constructions are being carried out, since the petitioner has neither named any persons, who may be culpable and has also joined disparate issues in one matter, on the face of it, this petition is found to not only be bereft of particulars but is even otherwise not maintainable.

In view of the circumstances, the instant petition, is hereby dismissed in limine along with listed applications.
