This petition was filed by the petitioner Nazeer Ahmed on 19.7.2012 with the following prayers:-

- a) To direct the respondent No.4 not to harass the petitioner and petitioner may allow to run his hotel which is under the premises of Bus Stand/Stop at Tando Boraho Main Road Sukkur to Ghotki.
- b) To declare that the hotel of the petitioner is within the premises of Bus and Truck Stand situated at Tando Boraho Taluka Rohri District Sukkur.

The respondent No.4 files his statement stating therein that the petitioner wants to run his hotel in the month of Holy Ramzan, for which neither the police is competent to permit him to run his hotel in such month nor the police has any concern with such matter.

The petitioner is also present and submits that since the very day of this month of Holy Ramzan his hotel is lying closed which is not being allowed to open for running his hotel business situated at Bus Stand/Stop. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that under section 5(b) of Ehtram-e-Ramzan Ordinance, 1981 and order dated 04.7.2012 issued by the D.C.Sukkur, the hotel situated at a bus stand can run its business in accordance with law.

In view of above, this petition is hereby disposed of with permission to the petitioner to approach the competent authority who shall decide the matter of the petitioner within three days of the receipt of the copy of this order through the petitioner.
