“With the consent of AAG, the petitioner is directed to submit an application to respondent No. 2, enclosing therewith following documents within a period of two weeks of the date of this order. The respondent No.2 is directed to process and get the case of the Petitioner decided within a period of two months thereafter.

- (i) Copy of Agreement Bond signed by the applicant/plot donor and EDO (E) regarding construction of school building,
- (ii) Copy of Form VII-B duly signed by Mukhtiarkar (Land Revenue) concerned showing the ownership of plot/land of the applicant,
- (iii) N.O.C of other shareholders of land/ plot and other heirs of property,
- (iv) Qualification certificates, CNIC, Domicile and PRC of the applicant, Certificate from relevant officer that land donated for construction of school building stand transferred in the name of Education & Literacy Department, Government of Sindh.”

Accordingly, the Petition, in the foregoing terms, stands disposed of.
