This criminal miscellaneous application is directed against the order dated 17.10.2017 whereby learned Additional Sessions Judge-V/Ex-Officio Justice of Peace, Larkana disposed of the application bearing Cr.Misc.A No.1307/2017 filed by the applicant U/S 22-A and B Cr.P.C leaving the applicant at liberty to approach the concerned police for redressal of his grievance and in case his grievance remained unredressed, the applicant was left at liberty to apply for issuance of proper directions to concerned police.


Learned counsel for the applicant states that the applicant filed an application U/S 22 A and B, Cr.P.C seeking directions for respondent No.1 i.e SHO P.S Seehar, Taluka Dokri, to register an FIR against the proposed accused on the ground that he was license holder of catching fishes from Old Nara and on 27.6.2017 he alongwith Mumtaz and Mir Ali were available at the bank of Nara where proposed accused persons duly armed with deadly weapons appeared and issuing threats to him took away 50 monds of fish. Learned counsel further submits that after disposal of

his application by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-V/Ex-Officio Justice of Peace, Larkana, applicant approached the SHO

concerned and even to SSP Larkana for redressal of his grievance but in vain. Learned counsel for the applicant however, admitted that on being refused the applicant did not approach the Additional Sessions Judge-V/Ex-Officio Justice of Peace, Larkana as per the directions vide impugned order dated 17.10.2017, on being remained his grievances unredressed.

Under the circumstances, this application is disposed of directing the applicant that he should first approach the concerned Ex-Officio Justice of Peace, Larkana if he still feels aggrieved, as per terms of order dated 17.10.2017 passed in Cr. Misc.A. No.1307/2017.

The application stands disposed of.
