ORDER

AMJAD ALI SAHITO, J -- Through this Bail Application, applicant/accused seeks post-arrest bail in Crime No.74/2024 registered under Section 9(1)6(d), 9(2)9 of CNS Act, 1997, AA/2022 at PS ANF MACHS Korangi, Karachi, after his bail plea has been declined by learned Special Court-1, CNS, Karachi.

2. The details and particulars of the FIR are already available in the bail application and FIR, same could be gathered from the copy of FIR attached with such application, hence, needs not to reproduce the same hereunder.

3. Per learned counsel, the applicant is only clearing agent and he has no concern with the alleged offence. He submits that in fact the I.O of the case has been dismissed from his service due to corruption charges who has submitted challan which is violation of the principle of justice. As such, the applicant/accused is entitled for concession of bail.

4. None present for the Special Prosecutor ANF, no intimation is received.

5. I have perused the record which reflects that SIP Dilshad Ahmed received information that drug smuggler Wahid Ali through his clearing agent Sameer Ali, the present applicant/accused is sending drugs to different countries in boxes of Habshi Halwa though they intercepted four shipments parcels and cardboard cartons and recovered 1/1 packets of Ice/Methamphetamine weighing 3600 grams so also 2100 grams of Heroin. The punishment provided by the law is minimum 09 years and the maximum is 14 years. As such, the applicant/accused is not entitled for concession of bail.

6. Resultantly, the instant Criminal Bail Application is **dismissed**. However, learned trial court is directed to expedite the matter and conclude the same preferably within 60 days from the date of receipt of this order and submit such compliance report through learned MIT-II of this Court.
