ORDER

AMJAD ALI SAHITO, J -- Through this Bail Application, the applicant/accused seek post-arrest bail in Crime No.297 of 2024 registered under Sections 24 SAA at Police Station Jackson, after his bail plea has been declined by the learned IVth Additional Sessions Judge West, Karachi, vide order dated 03.02.2025.

2. The details and particulars of the FIR are already available in the bail application and FIR, same could be gathered from the copy of FIR attached with such application, hence, needs not to reproduce the same hereunder.

3. Per learned counsel for the applicant, at the time of arrest, the applicant was booked in another case being Crime No.294 of 2024 registered under Sections 324, 452, 34 PPC R/w 109, 202, 216, 302, 337-FIII at Police Station Jackson He further submits that the applicant has been granted bail in the main case; as such, he is entitled for bail in the present case.

4. On the other hand, learned Addl. P.G. has opposed for grant of bail.

5. Heard the parties and perused the material available on record.

6. Since, the applicant has been granted bail in the main case bearing Criminal Bail Application No.456 of 2025 by this Court; as such, this case becomes the case of further enquiry. Resultantly, the instant bail application is **allowed**. The applicant/accused named above is granted post-arrest bail subject to furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/- and P.R. bonds in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

7. Needless to mention here that the observations made hereinabove are tentative in nature and would not influence the learned trial Court while deciding the case of the applicant/accused on merits.
