ORDER

MIRAN MUHAMMAD SHAH, J.- Through this Criminal Revision Application the Applicant / Complainant has challenged the Order dated 19.04.2023 passed by learned 7th Additional Sessions Judge in I.D. Complaint no.23 of 2023 (Ali

Khan vs. Akbar and others) whereby learned Trial Court dismissed the I.D. Complaint of Applicant / Complainant.

- 2. Today Counsel for the Applicant/Complainant is called absent. No intimation is received. This has been the case since last two years. He has not been appearing in this Court. It seems that the Counsel Applicant/Complainant for the well as as Applicant/Complainant have lost their interest in this case. 5. Therefore, in such circumstances, the present Criminal Revision Application No.S-70 of 2023 is dismissed and the Order passed by the learned 7th Additional Sessions Judge Hyderabad in I.D. Complaint No.23 of 2023 (Ali Khan Versus Akbar and others) is upheld.
