- 2-3. Through this Criminal Bail Application, the applicants/accused (1) Farhan Gohar Mallick son of Ali Gohar Mallick, (2) Osama Altaf son of Mohammad Altaf and (3) Syed Kazim Ali Rizvi son of Syed Salman Mohsin Rizvi seek protective/transitory bail in FIR No.185/2025 under Section-18, 21(1)(c), 21(1)(d) and 22 of the Prevention of Electronic Crimes, Act, 2016, registered at P.S Berot District Hub. Learned counsel for the applicants/ accused inter alia contends that the applicants/accused are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present crime with malafide intention; that the applicants intend to surrender before the trial Court at Hub Balochistan to seek pre-arrest bail but apprehend of their arrest at the doorstep of the Court by the hands of police, hence this application for protective/transitory bail.

Without touching the merits of the case, the applicants are granted protective/transitory bail for a period of <u>15 days</u> from today i.e 16.10.2025 to 30.10.2025 (both days inclusive), subject to furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/- (Rupees One Hundred Thousand Only) each and P.R bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Nazir of this Court.

This protective bail shall cease to have its effect after expiry of 15 days period i.e. **30.10.2025** or when the Applicants surrender themselves before the concerned Court, whichever be earlier. It is, however, made clear that in case, the applicants fail to make their appearance before the trial Court within a prescribed time, the surety submitted before this Court shall stand forfeited.

Instant bail application stands disposed of.
