## ORDER

Imtiaz Ali Birohi has filed this petition seeking directions for (i) DIG Larkana range and IG Police Sindh to improve the law and order situation in District Kambar-ShahdatKot and (ii) Directing Inspector General of Police Sindh to transfer SSP Kambar-ShahdatKot who is an SP and, in his place, appoint an SSP so that law and order in the District be maintained.

- 2. Learned counsel has argued that the current SSP has been harassing the petitioner on political grounds; the number of police personnel in Kambar is less than what is required; oil smuggling is taking place and law and order situation in the District is not good; the current SSP had raided the house of the petitioner who is a social worker and detained several people.
- We have heard the learned counsel.
- 4. The petition appears to be motivated with the desire to pressurize the police, which is conducting an extensive operation in the Kamber district and adjoining districts against dacoits and during which operation several police men have also lost their lives in the line of duty. The police cannot be restricted from carrying out its lawful duties. The petitioner has approached no other forum or authority with his grievance

but has preferred to directly come to court insisting that notice be issued to the Respondents. Maintaining law and order is primarily the duty of the executive. However, it is expected that the police will act in accordance with the law at all times.

Petition stands dismissed in limine. A copy of this order be sent to 5. the SSP Kambar-ShahdatKot as well as to the learned Additional Advocate General.
