adequate remedy is available to aggrieved person and since remedy in the

present case is available to the petitioner before the Ex-officio Justice of

Peace concerned under section 22-A(6)(i) Cr.P.C, the petition before this court

is not maintainable. Therefore, this petition is disposed of by directing the

petitioner to approach first to the concerned Ex-officio Justice of Peace for the

redressal of his grievance in accordance with law.
