Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have contracted marriage with their free will and consent. He contends that on account of such marriage, the private respondents have become annoyed and, at their behest, the official respondents are harassing the petitioners.

Learned Assistant Advocate General, Sindh, has already filed statements on behalf of respondents No. 2, 3, 4 and 5. In their statements, the official respondents have categorically denied the allegations of harassment and have submitted that neither have they caused any harassment to the petitioners nor do they intend to do so. Learned Assistant Advocate General further undertakes that the official respondents shall act strictly in accordance with law and shall provide protection to the petitioners, if so required.

Private respondents No. 8 and 10 have also filed their statements, wherein they have categorically stated that they have neither harassed the petitioners nor intend to do so in future.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, after going through the statements filed by the official as well as private respondents, submits that he does not press the instant petition, particularly in view of the statement submitted by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Larkana, whereby directions have been issued to the S.H.O, P.S. Waleed, to ensure protection to the petitioners in accordance with law.

In view of the statements filed and the submissions made at the bar, this petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No. 2 and 4 to ensure that no harassment is caused to the petitioners and to provide protection to them, as and when required, strictly in accordance with law.
