1. Urgency is granted.
2. to 4. Through the instant criminal bail application, applicants Ali Gul, Ahmed Ali, Aijaz Ali and Javed Ali seek protective bail in Crime No. 123/2025 of P.S. Waggan, for the offence U/S 365-B, 363, 148, 149 P.P.C, 3 T.I.P Act, 2018.

Learned counsel for the applicants submits that applicants are innocent and they have falsely been implicated in this case by the complainant due to malafide intention and ulterior motives of the complainant. He further submits that after investigation, the police disposed of the case under "C" class; however, the learned Magistrate took cognizance and trial Court has issued Non-Bailable Warrants against the applicants. Learned counsel contends that the applicants are law abiding citizens and intend to surrender before the learned trial Court, but they apprehend their arrest by the police in order to humiliate and disgrace them.

Heard. Without touching merits of the case and purely as an interim relief to enable the applicants to surrender before the competent Court, the applicants are admitted to protective bail for a period of seven days from today, subject to their furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) each and P.R bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this court.

In the meantime, the Non-Bailable Warrants, if any, issued against the applicants shall remain suspended.

The applicants are directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within the aforesaid period and join the investigation/trial, as the case may be.

This order shall cease to have its effect after the expiry of seven days (07) **from** today or upon surrender of the applicants before the concerned Court, whichever is earlier. The bail application is disposed of.
