Accordingly, the learned Trial Court is directed to examine two eye/material witnesses within a period of one month and submit such compliance to this Court. The Applicant is at liberty to file a fresh Bail Application before Trial Court on the basis of material collected by the Trial Court. The SSP, Hyderabad, is further directed to ensure the attendance of the said witnesses before the Trial Court.
