On the last date of hearing, a report was called from the learned District & Sessions Judge, Umerkot/Trial Court for verification of the compromise filed earlier. Such report is received which states that reports were called from the Mukhtiarkar Taluka Samaro (Revenue) and the S.H.O, P.S, Samaro, who have confirmed that Mst. Sasui (deceased) died un-married, leaving behind legal heirs (1) Muhammad Hassan (Father/complainant), (2) Mst. Aami (Mother), (3) Mian Bux (Brother), (4) Muhammad Ali (Brother) and (5) Rafique (Brother). After such verification, publication was made in the daily *Kawish* dated 21.02.2026; however, no one appeared to oppose the compromise.

Statements of the legal heirs were recorded in open Court, wherein they stated that they have entered into a compromise with the accused in the name of Almighty Allah and have waived their rights of Qisas and Diyat. They further confirmed that they have not received any compensation in this regard.

In view of the above, the compromise application already filed before this Court under Section 345(2) Cr.P.C is accepted and the application filed under Section 345(6) Cr.P.C for acquittal of the appellant/accused is allowed. Consequently, the present appellant is acquitted of all the charges as per the compromise accepted. He may be released forthwith if not required in any other case.
