Atta Muhammad &amp; others) arising out of Crime No.324 of 2023 registered at Police Station Badin for offences under Section 324, 336, 337-A(i), 504, 337L(ii), 147, 148, 149-PPC. After full dressed Trial, the Appellants was convicted by the Trial Court, hence they preferred the instant Appeal.</p> <p>During pendency of present Appeal, the parties entered into compromise outside the court and filed Applications under Section 345(2) Cr.P.C <b>(bearing M.A No.3706/26)</b> and Application U/s 345 (6) Cr.P.C <b>(bearing M.A No.3707/26)</b>.</p> <p>Complainant Zahid Ali and injured Muhammad Nadeem are present in Court and they both stated that they have entered into compromise with Appellant and they have forgiven the Appellant including the Arsh amount in the name of Almighty Allah. They further stated that they have also filed their affidavits before this Court along with compromise Application.</p>

On the other hand, learned Deputy Prosecutor General has recorded his no objections on the acquittal of appellant due to compromise between the parties and offence being compoundable.

Admittedly, offences against which a conviction has been awarded to the Appellants are compoundable.

In view of above, Applications under Section 345(2) Cr.P.C (**bearing M.A No.3706/26**) and Application U/s 345 (6) Cr.P.C (**bearing M.A No.3707/26**) are hereby **allowed**. Appellants named above are **acquitted** by means of compromise under Section 365(6) Cr.P.C. Accordingly, the instant Cr. Appeal stands disposed of alongwith pending application(s), if any.
