ORDER

RIAZAT ALI SAHAR. J. - The instant Constitutional Petition under Article 199 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 has been filed by the petitioner, seeking directions for immediate recovery and safe production of the her daughter namely Miss Sobia Maryam, who has allegedly been abducted and unlawfully confined by Respondents No.6 to 10, as well as for compelling the official respondents to discharge their constitutional and statutory obligations in accordance with law.

2. The background of the case, as alleged, is that the Petitioner's daughter namely Miss Sobia Maryam went missing from the Petitioner's house at Hyderabad on 13.04.2026 under highly suspicious circumstances after Respondents No.6 to 10,

who had stayed overnight as guests, suddenly disappeared from the premises. Subsequently, FIR No.73 of 2026 under Sections 365-B and 34 PPC was registered at Police Station Makki Shah, Hyderabad; however, despite registration of the case, the official respondents failed to ensure recovery of the detainee, thereby constraining the Petitioner to invoke the constitutional jurisdiction of this Honorable Court.

3. Since FIR bearing Crime No.73/2026 has already been registered at Police Station Makki Shah, Hyderabad under Sections 365-B and 34 PPC regarding the alleged abduction of Miss Sobia Maryam daughter of Imran Khan, the matter is presently under investigation and does not fall within the ambit of illegal detention or missing person jurisdiction. Accordingly, the Investigating Officer is directed to make all possible efforts for tracing and recovering the alleged abductee and to proceed strictly in accordance with law. Compliance report/progress in the matter shall be communicated to this Court.

4. The instant petition stands **disposed of** in the above terms.
