Mr. Muhammad Akram Sahito advocate for petitioners along with petitioners.

M/s. Ayaz Ali Rajper Assistant A.G. Sindh and Siraj Ahmed Bijarani A.P.G. Sindh along with Shabana Chandio WHC PS Women, District Shaheed Benazirabad.

Mr. Abdul Hameed Bajwa advocate files Vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No.7, taken on record.

The petitioners are present along with their learned counsel. Petitioner No.1 Mst. Amna submits that she being *sui juris* has contracted a lawful marriage with petitioner No.2, Kashif Ali on account of her own free will and consent without any coercion or compulsion. She further submits that her father, the respondent No.7, being provoked by the un-ceremonial marriage, has lodged a false FIR No.06 of 2026 at Police Station Women and Children District Shaheed Benazirabad, under Sections 3 / 4 of the Child Marriage Act.

Today, the WHC PS Women appeared before the Court and submitted that he has recorded the statement of petitioner No.1 under Section 161 Cr.P.C. In her statement, petitioner No.1 reiterated the facts previously stated by her and categorically denied the allegations levelled in the FIR. She further stated that she is about 18/19 years of age and that the FIR has been falsely lodged. She also expressed her free will and consent to continue residing with her husband.

In view of the statement of the alleged abductee, the WHC PS Women submits that he shall submit a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. before the learned concerned Magistrate within seven (07) days, for seeking appropriate orders in accordance with law.

At this juncture, learned counsel for respondent No.5 submits that petitioner No.1 is of minor age. She is at liberty to first agitate such

fact before the WHC Women (I.O.) and then before the learned Magistrate while passing order over report under section 173 Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands **disposed of** in the above terms along with listed application.
