Mr. Aqeel Ahmed Shaikh advocate for petitioners along with petitioners.

M/s. Rafique Ahmed Dahri Assistant A.G. Sindh and Shahid Ahmed Shaikh D.P.G. Sindh along with ASI Ghulam Nabi Mirani I.O. PS Waleed District Larkana.

Mr. Mushtaque Ahmed Abro advocate files Vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No.8 along with Photostat copies of Primary, Intermediate Certificates and Certificate (below the age of 18 years) issued by NADRA of the petitioner No.1 under the cover of his statement, taken on record.

The petitioners are present along with their learned counsel. Petitioner No.1 Mst. Maria @ Haleema submits that she being *sui juris* has contracted a lawful marriage with petitioner No.2, Rafique Ahmed on account of her own free will and consent without any coercion or compulsion. She further submits that her father, the respondent No.8, being provoked by the un-ceremonial marriage, has lodged a false FIR No.49 of 2026 at Police Station Waleed District Larkana, under Sections 366-A, 452, 34 PPC.

Today, the Investigating Officer appeared and submitted that he has recorded the statement of petitioner No.1 under Section 161 Cr.P.C. In her statement, she reaffirmed the previously stated facts and clearly denied the allegations contained in the FIR regarding kidnapping or wrongful confinement. She further expressed her intention to continue residing with her husband.

In view of the statement of the alleged abductee, the Investigating Officer submits that he shall submit a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. before the learned concerned Magistrate within seven (07) days, for seeking appropriate orders in accordance with law.

At this juncture, learned counsel for respondent No.8 submits that petitioner No.1 is of minor age. She is at liberty to first agitate such

fact before the Investigating Officer and then before the learned Magistrate while passing order over report under section 173 Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands **disposed of** in the above terms.
