ORDER

MIRAN MUHAMMAD SHAH, J:- This order shall dispose of the above-captioned three criminal bail applications filed by the applicants. Criminal Bail Application No.605/2026 is a pre-arrest bail application filed by applicant Anar Gul s/o Almargul, whereas Criminal Bail Application No.609/2026 is a post-arrest bail application filed by applicants Ateeq-ur-Rehman s/o Rais Khan and Mst. Nabila w/o Saif-ur-Rehman. Both applications arise out of FIR No.271/2025 registered at Police Station Ittehad Town under Sections 302, 324, and 34 PPC. Criminal Bail Application No.610/2026 is also a post-arrest bail application filed by applicant Ateeq-ur-Rehman arising out of Crime No.274/2025 registered at the same police station under Section 23(i)(a) of the Sindh Arms Act, which is an offshoot of the main case. Since both crimes are interconnected, therefore, for the sake of convenience, consistency, and to avoid conflicting findings, all these applications are being decided through this single consolidated order. Earlier, the bail applications filed by the applicants seeking the same relief were dismissed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-II, Karachi West, vide orders dated 30.01.2026.

2. The facts of the case need not be reproduced herein, as copies of the FIRs are attached with the bail applications and the facts have already been stated therein in detail.

3. I have heard the learned counsel for the applicants as well as the learned APG and have also perused the record.

4. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the parties have amicably settled their dispute with the intervention of respectable persons of the locality. He further submits that the legal heirs of deceased Saif-ur-Rehman, namely Muhammad Idris (brother of the deceased), Mst. Gul Mina Bibi (widow of the deceased), and Mst. Naik Awaza Bibi (mother of the deceased), have filed affidavits stating that they have no objection to the grant of bail to the applicants. The learned APG raised objection that some of the offences are non-compoundable. The legal heirs, who are present before the Court, have confirmed the contents of their affidavits and stated that they have no objection if the bail applications of the applicants/accused are allowed. Perusal of FIR No.271/2025, which is the main murder case, shows that the offences involved are compoundable in nature, and the learned counsel has stated that a proper compromise application shall be filed before the trial Court. In these circumstances, Criminal Bail Application No.605/2026 is allowed, and the interim pre-arrest bail granted to applicant Anar Gul vide order dated 24.02.2026 is hereby confirmed on the same terms and conditions. Similarly, Criminal Bail Application No.609/2026 is also allowed, and applicants Ateeq-ur-Rehman and Mst. Nabila are admitted to post-arrest bail subject to furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/- (Rupees One Hundred Thousand only) each and P.R. bonds in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court. As regards Criminal Bail Application No.610/2026, the same pertains to an offshoot case under Section 23(i)(a) of the Sindh Arms Act against applicant Ateeq-ur-Rehman,

which is a non-compoundable offence. However, since bail has already been granted to the applicants in the main case under Section 302 PPC, and in order to maintain peace and harmony between the parties, the applicant Ateeq-ur-Rehman is also admitted to post-arrest bail in the said case subject to furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand only) and P.R. bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

5. Needless to mention here that the observations made herein above are tentative in nature and would not influence the trial court while deciding the case of the applicant on merits.
