ORDER.

Adnan-ul-Karim Memon J:- The petitioners, Mst. Aameena and Faraz Ahmed filed this Constitutional Petition under Article 199 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, seeking quashment of FIR No.92 of 2026 registered at Police Station Mirwah, District Khairpur, under Section 365-B PPC, along with interim protection, non-arrest, and directions against harassment by police and the private respondent, Nizamuddin, ex-husband of petitioner No.1.

2. It is the case of the petitioners that petitioner No.1, after obtaining a divorce from respondent No.5, contracted a free-will marriage with petitioner No.2 as a sui juris person. They relied upon the nikahnama and affidavit of free will. Earlier, this Court, vide order dated 07.05.2026, had taken notice of their apprehension of arrest and issued notices to the respondents.

3. During proceedings, the Investigating Officer appeared and submitted that upon recording the statement of petitioner No.1, he would finalize the investigation and submit a report before the learned Magistrate for appropriate orders. Learned counsel for the

petitioners, on this statement, agreed to the disposal of the petition.

4. Accordingly, by consent, the petition is disposed of along with the listed application. It is, however, directed that no arrest shall be made, and the Investigating Officer shall complete the investigation after recording the statement of petitioner No.1 and submit the report before the concerned Magistrate in accordance with law.
