**ORDER**

**Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J**:- The petitioners, have filed the instant Constitutional Petition under Article 199 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, seeking quashment of FIR No.100 of 2026 registered at Police Station Pano Akil under Sections 365, 395, 148 and 149 PPC, constitution of a Joint Investigation Team, suspension of the impugned FIR and consequential proceedings, and disposal of their pending application.

2. It was contended that FIR No.100 of 2026 was registered on 03.05.2026 regarding an incident allegedly occurring on 18.04.2026, and that on the following day, another FIR No.101 of 2026 was lodged at the same police station concerning substantially the same occurrence. The petitioners' counsel maintained that both cases were false and fabricated, lodged to victimize them after they had initiated proceedings against certain police officials. He further stated that petitioners had already obtained interim pre-arrest bail in the subject crimes and that the matter is under investigation, which needs to be conducted fairly in accordance with the law.

3. We have heard the learned counsel for the parties present in court and perused the material placed on record with their assistance.

4. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court considered it appropriate that the allegations raised in the petition be examined by the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Sukkur Range, by hearing the concerned parties within two weeks' time.

5. Accordingly, the DIGP, Sukkur Range so far as the FIRS are concerned is directed to inquire into the grievances of the petitioners and, if the allegations against the police officials are found correct, he shall take departmental action against the responsible police officials; however, if the complaint is found to be false, appropriate action shall be recommended in accordance with law.

6. The petition, along with the listed application, stands disposed of with the aforesaid directions. The said exercise shall be completed within two weeks, and a copy of this order shall be communicated to the DIGP, Sukkur Range, for compliance.
