ORDER

Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J:- Petitioner Allah Dino filed this constitutional petition under Article 199 of the Constitution seeking release of his pension and other retirement benefits, contending that although he served as a Constable since 1988 and retired on 14.12.2025, his pensionary dues were withheld without any lawful justification.

2. At the hearing, the learned Assistant A.G. submitted that the delay occurred due to an incorrect CNIC entry in the SAP system of the District Accounts Office, Sukkur. He stated that Form FO-II for correction of the CNIC had already been prepared and forwarded to the District Accounts Officer vide letter dated 26.03.2026, and the correction would be made within one week, after which the petitioner's pensionary benefits would be released. The petitioner is ready to cooperate with the authorities.

4. In view of the above, since the grievance of the petitioner is purely administrative in nature arising out of a clerical error in the CNIC entry in the SAP system, and the official respondents have already initiated corrective steps by forwarding Form FO-II for rectification, no further adjudication on merits is required at this stage.

5. The respondents are under a constitutional and legal obligation to ensure the timely disbursement of pensionary benefits, which are a valuable vested right of a retired public

servant and cannot be withheld on account of technical or procedural lapses.

6. Accordingly, the respondents are directed to strictly adhere to the timeline already stated and finalize the correction process expeditiously, preferably within the stipulated period, ensuring release of all admissible pensionary benefits thereafter without further delay.

7. The petition is disposed of in the above terms.
