***Adnan-ul-Karim Memon. J;*** Petitioner Ganga, widow of Chandar Bhan, filed this constitutional petition under Article 199 of the Constitution seeking a declaration of her entitlement, as a widowed daughter of a deceased government employee, to family pension along with arrears and regular monthly payments.

The record shows that the petitioner's mother was a permanent employee of the Local Government Department, Government of Sindh. After her death, the family pension was not released in favour of the petitioner, leading to the filing of this petition.

Learned counsel for Respondent No. 4 submitted that certain codal formalities are required from the petitioner and, upon their completion, pensionary benefits will be released within three weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertook to complete the required formalities within two weeks.

In view of the statements of the parties, and with their consent, this petition is disposed of with directions that the petitioner shall complete the requisite formalities within two weeks, and the respondents shall release the pensionary benefits within three weeks thereafter.

In case of non-compliance, appropriate proceedings under Article 204 of the Constitution may be initiated against the delinquent officials.
