Learned counsel for the applicant submits that initially Criminal Miscellaneous Application No.S-39/2025 was filed by the applicant with regard to the cancellation of bail. On 19.03.2025, on the basis of compromise, this Court had directed both the parties to submit their compromise applications before the learned trial Court on or before 21.03.2025. Consequently, compromise applications under Sections 345(2) and 345(6) Cr.P.C. were filed by both parties on 12.04.2025. The learned Civil Judge and Judicial Magistrate, Larkana, vide order dated 12.06.2025, disposed of the said applications and accepted the compromise. However, the aforesaid order neither reflects the particulars of the cheques in question nor discloses the nature of the transaction between the parties on the basis of which the compromise was effected. The learned Court merely accepted the compromise in accordance with law without recording such details in its order.

Now the contention of the applicant is with regard to dishonoring of four cheques bearing No.0000000018, dated 12.05.2025, No.0000000019 dated 12.06.2025, No.0000000020 dated 14.07.2025 and No.0000000016 dated 12.08.2025, for which he is at liberty to approach the proper forum by exhausting the remedy provided under the law.

In view of above, instant Criminal Miscellaneous Application stands disposed of.
