**Omar Sial, J.** Applicant Qudratullah seeks post arrest bail in Crime No.1198/2025 registered by PS Ferozabad, East, Karachi under Section 397, 34 PPC. Earlier bail application moved on behalf of the applicant was dismissed vide order dated 22.04.2026 by the learned 5<sup>th</sup> Additional Sessions Judge/MCTC, Karachi East.

2. The facts as narrated in the FIR allege that the complainant, on 30.11.2025, at about 7:00 PM, while returning home on his motorcycle bearing No. KQC-9627 (Suzuki 150), he reached near Bohri Jamaat Khana before Baloch Colony Bridge on Shaheed-e-Millat Road, Karachi. At that time, two unknown young men riding an unregistered motorcycle, dressed in shalwar kameez and armed with weapons, stopped him and snatched his Samsung Galaxy mobile phone bearing IMEI Nos. 152780150027374 and (2) 352195530027376, then fled from the scene.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant as well as the learned Deputy Prosecutor General. My observations and findings are as follows.

4. The complainant who was robbed has categorically identified the applicant as the person who robbed him. No malafide on his part is claimed or inflicted from the record. In view of the alarming

rise in street crime and the applicant's identification, bail is dismissed.

5. These are the reasons for the short order dated 08.06.2026, whereby this Crl. Bail Application was dismissed.
