Applicant Ubaidullah seeks post arrest bail in Crime No.157/2025 registered by PS Iqbal Market under Section 3,4,14, Foreign Act, 1946. Earlier bail application moved on behalf of the applicant was dismissed vide order dated 12.05.2026 by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-IV, West Karachi.

The facts as narrated in FIR are that Complainant Muhammad Afzal, along with SI Malik Aziz, interrogated the arrested accused namely Iqbal son of Khanzada, Rehman alias Jalandar Khan, and Obaidullah son of Muhammad Yousaf in FIR No. 156/2025 under Sections 365, 377, 337-A(i)/34 PPC. During interrogation, accused Obaidullah failed to produce any CNIC or other document proving his Pakistani nationality and disclosed that he is an Afghan national, while his parents reside in Quetta. Consequently, he was found to be a foreign national illegally residing in Pakistan and was arrested under Sections 3/4/14 of the Foreigners Act in the presence of witnesses PC Aftab Shah and PC Moaiz.

I have heard learned counsel for the applicant, the learned Deputy Prosecutor General Sindh and Assistant Director (Legal) NADRA and have perused the material available on record.

In compliance of the previous order dated 11.06.2026, NADRA has filed its report. The prompt action of NADRA is appreciated. The report shows that Ubaidullah is a Pakistani citizen according to NADRA report. I.O is also present and very frankly concedes that the applicant is a Pakistani national in view of the NADRA report. The case against the applicant is one of the further inquiry. Accordingly, the applicant is admitted to post-arrest bail subject to his furnishing a solvent surety in the sum of Rs.5,000/- and a PR bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
