Applicant Muzammil son of Furqan Shah seeks post arrest bail in Crime No.55 of 2025 registered by PS SITE-A, Karachi under Section 324, 34 PPC. Earlier bail application moved on behalf of the applicant was dismissed vide order dated 18.03.2026 by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-II, Karachi.

The facts as set out in FIR are that on 01.02.2025 at about 2:10 a.m., the complainant's father, Inspector Hanif Shah, after completing his duty, was proceeding towards his home when, near Siemens Chowrangi, four unidentified persons riding two motorcycles allegedly intercepted him, caused him to fall, and fired upon him with the intention to kill. As a result, he sustained a firearm injury to his abdomen and was shifted to hospital for treatment. The assailants allegedly fled from the scene, while the victim's service revolver and cash amounting to Rs.94,500/- were taken into police custody. On the basis of these allegations, the present FIR was registered against unknown accused persons.

I have heard learned counsel for the applicant as well as the learned Deputy Prosecutor General and have perused the material available on record.

The son of the complainant on the previous date had appeared and said that the family has no objection if the bail is granted. The Court, not being satisfied with the statement, requested the Investigating Officer to send somebody to the complainant's house and

ask himself whether he was willing to forgive the applicant. Investigating Officer has submitted his report, which shows that a Sub-Inspector went to the injured complainant, who without any fear told him that he has no objection, if the bail is granted to the applicant.

Given the above, the applicant is admitted to post-arrest bail subject to his furnishing a solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/- and PR bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
