Applicants Ghulam Murtaza and Ramzan seek post arrest bail in Crime No.403/2026 registered by PS Shah Latif Town under Section 392, 397, 34 PPC. Earlier bail application moved on behalf of the applicants was dismissed vide order dated 07.04.2026 by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-VIII, Malir Karachi.

As per the FIR, the complainant, Asad Ali alleged that on 25.02.2026 at about 4:30 p.m., near Fast University, Shah Latif Town, Karachi, two armed persons riding a motorcycle intercepted him and, at gunpoint, snatched his Samsung Galaxy Note 20 mobile phone, cash amounting to Rs.4,000/-, bank cards, service card, copies of CNICs, motorcycle documents, and wristwatch. Subsequently, on 27.02.2026, the complainant saw on social media that two persons had been arrested in an injured condition after a police encounter near Fast University. Upon seeing their photographs, he identified them as the same persons who had robbed him and came to know their names as Ghulam Murtaza son of Ghulam Mustafa and Ramzan son of Ali Hassan, who had already been arrested in other criminal cases, for which the present case.

I have heard learned counsel for the applicants, the learned Deputy Prosecutor General Sindh as well as complainant present in person and have perused the material available on record.

The complainant is present in person. He says that he thought he had identified the applicants through a social media post which came on his mobile. At that time, the faces of boys who had been caught were not clear. He went to the police station saw boys and confirms that these are not people who had robbed him. The complainant is an employee of NAB and does not look afraid of anybody to make a false statement. The case against the applicants is one of the further inquiry. Accordingly, the applicants are admitted to post-arrest bail against a surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/- each and PR bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
