Complainant present in person

Applicant Ameen son of Mehmood Ali seeks post arrest bail in Crime No.627 of 2025 registered by PS Landhi Karachi under Section 392, 397, 34 PPC. Earlier 3rd bail application moved on behalf of the applicant was dismissed in default in non-prosecution vide order dated 13.01.2026 by the learned IVth-Additional Sessions Judge, Karachi East.

The facts, as set out in the FIR, are that on 03.10.2025 at about 9:00 p.m., two unidentified persons riding a motorcycle intercepted the complainant near Zauq Biryani Centre, Landhi No. 6, Karachi. One of them, armed with a pistol, allegedly deprived the complainant of his mobile phone, cash amounting to Rs.5,000/-, and a photocopy of his CNIC, and thereafter fled from the scene. The complainant stated that the accused persons were unknown to him but were visually identifiable. On the basis of these allegations, the present FIR was registered.

I have heard learned counsel for the applicant, the learned Additional Prosecutor General, assisted by the Investigating Officer of the case as well as complainant present in person and have perused the material available on record.

The complainant is present in person and has absolutely no reason to give as to why he reported this offence to the police on 10-10-2025 when his Vivo mobile phone was stolen on 03.10.2025. Doubt is created to the authenticity of the prosecution case when it is noticed that the phone which was stolen has not been recovered as yet. The case against the applicant is one of the further inquiry.

Given the above, the applicant is admitted to post-arrest bail subject to his furnishing a solvent surety in the sum of Rs.500,000/- and PR bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
