The prosecution's case is that on 19.03.2023 at about 0230 hours, the complainant lodged an FIR regarding an incident that allegedly occurred on 18.03.2023 at about 09:40 pm. According to the complainant, his nephew, Abdul Rafiq, informed him that Dawood Khan had been shot after leaving the port at Kemari with a loaded vehicle. After parking the vehicle, Dawood Khan sat with his friend Altaf. When the complainant reached the Civil Hospital, he found that Dawood Khan had succumbed to his injuries. It is alleged that during the incident, two unknown persons approached the deceased, demanded his belongings, and upon his refusal, fired two shots at him, causing fatal injuries.

The case was registered on 19.03.2023 for an incident which occurred on 18.03.2023. The FIR was lodged against two unknown people. A year later, the applicant was arrested despite there being absolutely no evidence of his involvement in the crime. I fail to see any reason why bail was dismissed by the learned trial Court. Muhammad Altaf was the only eye-witness to the incident who in his testimony stated that he cannot identify anybody. The case against the applicant is one of the further inquiry. Accordingly, the applicant is admitted to post-arrest bail subject to his furnishing a solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/- and PR bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
