ORDER

ZULFIQAR ALI SANGI, J.- Through instant Criminal Bail Application applicants Shaheen, Allah Warayo, Dilbar alias Daud Ali and Mujahid alias Mujahid Ali seek pre-arrest bail in Crime No.107 of 2025, registered at P.S, Sangi, under sections 452, 427, 382, 506/2, 147, 148 & 149 PPC. Their earlier bail plea was declined by learned trial Court vide order dated 11.02.2026.

2. The facts of the F.I.R. are mentioned in the bail application copy whereof is also attached with the memo of bail application, hence, need not to reproduce the same here.

3. Counsel for applicants contends that there is an inordinate delay of 20 days in the lodgment of the FIR, for which no plausible explanation has been furnished by the complainant; that enmity between the parties is admitted in the FIR; that no particulars of the allegedly stolen articles have been mentioned therein; therefore, the case of the applicants requires further enquiry, entitling them to the confirmation of the interim pre-arrest bail earlier granted to them by this Court. It is further contended that the complainant and

the witnesses have settled their dispute outside the Court, and the complainant has no objection if the interim pre-arrest bail earlier granted to the applicants is confirmed.

4. Conversely, learned Additional P.G. as well as learned counsel for the complainant, along with the complainant, who is present in Court, have conceded the request for confirmation of the interim pre-arrest bail on the ground that the matter has already been settled between the parties outside the Court.

5. The grounds so agitated by learned counsel for the applicants, coupled with the no objection raised by the complainant, entitle the applicants to the confirmation of the interim pre-arrest bail. Under these circumstances, this bail application is **allowed** and the interim pre-arrest bail earlier granted to the applicants by this Court vide order dated 18.02.2026 is hereby confirmed on the same terms and conditions.
