ORDER

ZULFIQAR ALI SANGI, J.- Through instant Criminal Bail Application No.S-422 of 2026, applicant Nisar Ahmed seeks post-arrest bail in Crime No.07 of 2026, registered at P.S, Sarhad, under sections 324, 337A(i), 337F(i), 337H(ii), 147,148,149, 504 PPC; whereas, in CrI. Bail Application No.427 of 2026, applicant Abdul Ghaffar seeks pre-arrest bail in Crime No.90 of 2026, registered at P.S, Mirpur Mathelo under sections 324, 114, 337A(ii), 337F(iii), 504, 34 PPC after rejection of their bail pleas by the trial Court.

2. The facts of the F.I.Rs are mentioned in the bail applications copies whereof are also attached with the memo of bail applications, hence, need not to reproduce the same here.

3. In both bail applications, learned counsel representing the applicants submit that there are counter cases registered in between the parties and it is yet to be determined by the trial Court as to which party is aggressor after recording evidence. It is further contended that the alleged offence, in which applicants are involved does not fall within the prohibitory clause of section 497 CrPC; whereas, applicability of section 324 PPC is yet to be

determined by the trial Court after recording evidence. After arguing at some length, both the parties conceded for grant of post arrest bail so also for confirmation of interim pre-arrest bail. Learned Additional P.G for the State, in view of their no objection, also conceded to the above proposal.

4. Since the offence with which the applicants are charged does not fall within prohibitory clause of section 497 CrPC and the parties have raised no objection in favour of each other coupled with no objection of learned APG, the applicants have succeeded to make out a case for confirmation of the interim pre-arrest bail as well as the grant of post-arrest bail. Under these circumstances, these bail applications are **allowed**, and the interim pre-arrest bail earlier granted to applicant **Abdul Ghaffar Solangi** in Crl. B.A.No.S-427 of 2026 by this Court vide order dated 12.05.2026 is hereby confirmed on the same terms and conditions; whereas applicant **Nisar Ahmed Solangi** in Crl. B.A.No.S-422 of 2026 is admitted to post-arrest bail subject to his furnishing solvent surety in the sum of **Rs.50,000/-** (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
