In compliance with this Court's order dated 24.06.2026, the Station House Officer, Police Station Women, Tando Allahyar, has produced the detinue, Mst. Naseeba d/o Malook, before the Court, together with the requisite report and memorandum of recovery.

The statement of the detinue was recorded before the learned Additional Registrar of this Court, wherein she deposed to the following effect:

She affirmed that she was of sound mind and fully competent to make her statement voluntarily, free from any pressure, coercion, inducement, or undue influence emanating from any quarter. Being sui juris, she had, of her own volition, contracted a love marriage with her cousin, the Applicant, Raja s/o Faqeer Muhammad, caste Wassan, on 22.05.2026. Notwithstanding the marriage, she thereafter resumed residence with her parents, during which period her father lodged FIR bearing Crime No. 28 of 2026 at Police Station Women, Tando Allahyar, invoking Sections 452, 365, and 506(ii) of the Pakistan Penal Code against the Applicant.

Consequent thereupon, she, together with her husband, preferred Constitutional Petition No. S-540 of 2026 before this Court, in the course of which her statement was recorded. She disclosed that the statement then made expressing an intention to reside with her parents, pursuant to which she was set at liberty, had been extracted under parental pressure and compulsion, and did not reflect her free will. She further disclosed that, while residing under her parents' influence, she had instituted a family suit for dissolution of marriage before the learned Family Judge, Tando Allahyar, which remains sub

judice; however, she no longer intends to pursue the same and proposes to withdraw it in accordance with law, having stated that the earlier statement made before this Court was similarly not voluntary.

She placed on record that the criminal case registered against her husband has since been disposed of as "C" Class. She voluntarily reaffirmed her desire to reside with her husband, the Applicant, as his legally wedded wife, within the bounds ordained by Almighty Allah, and prayed that she be permitted to accompany him accordingly. She additionally expressed apprehension of danger to her life and liberty at the hands of her parents and other relatives, and prayed that appropriate legal protection be extended to her and her husband in accordance with law.

Given that the detinue, Mst. Naseeba, being sui juris, has voluntarily expressed her intention to reside with her husband, the Applicant, Raja s/o Faqeer Muhammad, caste Wassan, who is present before the Court, she is accordingly set at liberty to accompany her husband forthwith.

In view of the foregoing, the instant application stands disposed of in the above terms. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Tando Allahyar, is directed to ensure the safety, security, and protection of the Applicant and his wife, in accordance with law.
