Mr. Amjad Ali Abro, Advocate files Vakalatnama as well as
objections on behalf of respondent No.4, taken on record. He opposed
the petition by contending that the petitioner No.1 is a minor daughter
of respondent No.4; hence, her Nikahnama with the petitioner No.2 is
void. Learned AAG files statements of respondent No.3, taken on record
and copy whereof is provided to counsel for the petitioners.

The Investigating Officer, Police Station Sachal, Karachi, is
present and submits that he has recorded the statement of petitioner
No.1, wherein she has stated that she is about 18 years of age and that
on 21.04.2026, she voluntarily left the house of her parents and
solemnized marriage with petitioner No.2. She has categorically denied
the allegations of kidnapping and asserted that her mother has lodged
a false FIR regarding her alleged abduction. Petitioner No.1, who is
present in Court, affirms the contents of her statement recorded today
under Section 161, Cr.P.C.

After recording the aforesaid statement, the I.O. submits that he shall submit a report before the learned concerned Magistrate recommending disposal of the case as "C-Class".

In view of the above circumstances, this petition is **disposed of** with directions to the I.O. to submit the report in view the statement of petitioner No.1 and his opinion as stated above, before the learned concerned Magistrate having jurisdiction within fifteen (15) days,. Upon submission of such report, respondent No.4 shall be at liberty to agitate all available grounds before the learned concerned Magistrate, who shall decide the matter strictly in accordance with law.

The official respondents are further directed to provide protection to the petitioners, as and when required.
