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Petitioners claim that, being *sui juris*, they contracted marriage with their own freewill and without any coercion. However, the private respondents, being their family members, became annoyed and have allegedly been continuously threatening and harassing them. Hence, the petitioners approached this Court seeking protection and restraining orders against the respondents from causing any harassment.

In compliance with the earlier order, SHO, Police Station Yaro Lund, has appeared and filed his reply to the show-cause notice along with a copy of his medical prescription, which is taken on record. The show-cause notice is hereby vacated. However, he is warned to remain careful in future.

SHO, Police Station Khaderi, has also appeared and filed, under cover of his statement, a copy of FIR bearing Crime No.54/2026, registered at Police Station Cantt., for offences punishable under Sections 457, 365-B, PPC and Section 3 of the Prevention of Trafficking in Persons Act, 2018, which is taken on record. He submits that he is the Investigating Officer of the said case, which has been lodged by the mother of petitioner No.1 alleging her abduction.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners has also filed, under cover of his statement, a copy of the examination-in-chief of petitioner No.1

(Mst. Mona), recorded on 22.07.2026 before the learned Additional Sessions Judge-I, Mirpur Mathelo, in Cr. M.A. No.61/2026, which is taken on record. In her examination-in-chief, petitioner No.1 has categorically stated that she voluntarily appeared before the Court for recording her statement and deposed that she contracted marriage with petitioner No.2 (Piyaro) on 17.06.2026 of her own freewill and desires to reside with her husband. Learned Additional Sessions Judge-I, Mirpur Mathelo, accordingly observed that, being *sui juris*, she was at liberty to go wherever she wished and disposed of the application.

The private respondents, who are present in Court, submit that they have not harassed the petitioners and undertake that they shall not do so in future. Learned AAG Sindh submits that the official respondents shall act strictly in accordance with law.

In view of the above, learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners shall approach the competent Court for quashment of the aforementioned FIR. He, however, seeks disposal of this petition.

Accordingly, this petition is **disposed of**. The respondents are directed to conduct themselves strictly in accordance with law. The official respondents are further directed to provide protection to the petitioners as and when so required, strictly in accordance with law.
