ORDER

Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J. Petitioner Aena Bibi filed the instant Constitutional Petition under Article 199 of the Constitution, seeking directions to the official respondents for issuance of CNICs/B-Forms/FRCs for herself and her family members.

2. Learned counsel for NADRA submitted that no tracking ID was available against the petitioner’s record linked with her father’s CNIC and advised that the petitioner may approach the nearest NADRA Centre for fresh CNIC processing in accordance with NADRA SOPs, along with the required supporting documents and verification of blood relatives.
3. Upon this statement, learned counsel for the petitioner expressed satisfaction and agreed to approach NADRA for fresh processing of the CNIC.
4. The petition needs to be disposed of as the grievance of the petitioner is found to be procedural in nature and NADRA provided a mechanism for fresh processing of the CNIC subject to fulfillment of prescribed requirements. Since the petitioner agreed to avail the available remedy and NADRA undertook to complete the process within the stipulated period, no further adjudication was required.
5. The matter is accordingly concluded/disposed of with mutual consent with the above directions.
