ORDER

Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J. The case of the petitioner is that respondent No.5 is raising unauthorized construction over Plot No.61-JM, 1016, near Hasnain Masjid, Muslimabad Cooperative Housing Society, Karachi, by creating units/portions and encroaching upon the KMC nala situated at the entrance of the plot. It is alleged that the construction is being carried out without approval of the competent authority and in connivance with the concerned officials. It is further submitted that despite complaints and a legal notice having been addressed to the relevant authorities, no effective action has been taken, and the construction is continuing. The petitioner further alleges that unauthorized utility connections have adversely affected the supply of water, electricity and gas to the residents of the locality.

2. Counsel for the SBCA submit that the petitioners are required to approach the SBCA under SCRM and decision shall be made, in accordance with law.

3. Without touching the merits of the case, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the SBCA with his complaint by using Smart Complaint Redressal Mechanism (SCRM) of the SBCA, who shall decide the same in accordance with its SOPs, after hearing all concerned.

4. The petition stands disposed of in the above terms along with listed / pending applications. A copy of this order shall be sent to DG SBCA for information.
