ORDER

Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J. Petitioner Mst. Naseema Ahmed has filed this Constitutional Petition under Article 199 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, with the following prayer: -

- a. *To direct the NADRA authorities for issuance of CNIC to the Petitioner as early as possible.*
- b. *Declaring there that all acts taken by the Respondents in this regard are void, abinitio and in operative open the right of Petitioner.*
- c. *Any other relief which this Honorable Court deems fit.*

2. The subject petition has been filed with non-compliance of Sections 79 and 80 of CPC, without impleading the necessary parties as that objection has been raised.

3. It appears that case of the Petitioner was processed for verification vide Board ID No.13100002252 and case referred to Verifying Agency due to insufficient evidence. Verifying Agency report received as subject person is not possessing documents as per policy vide letter dated 02.03.2022. In the light of such report, the case was forwarded to concerned DLC for decision. The Petitioner did not approach the DLC or concerned Verification Board for review or produced any other documentary evidence. However, the Petitioner is directed to approach the concerned Zonal Office along with all documents in original prior to 1979, The Alpha Family member for evaluation of the case as per revised Verification and Revocation Policy 5.0.0.

4. When confronted with the above position, learned counsel for the petitioner expressed satisfaction and sought disposal of the petition in the light of the statement made by the Assistant Director (Legal), NADRA. It is, however, observed that the aforesaid exercise shall be completed within a period of two weeks.

5. In view of the above, without touching the merits of the case and with consent of the parties, the petition is disposed of in the above terms.
