Through the instant application filed under Order XXIII Rule 3, C.P.C., the parties submit that they have amicably settled their dispute by way of compromise before the Hon’ble Federal Constitutional Court, Islamabad. It is further stated that in C.P.L.A. No.2795 of 2023, vide order dated 09.07.2026, the Hon’ble Federal Constitutional Court recorded as under:-

“Learned counsel for the parties present in Court submit that matter with regard to other civil and criminal litigation has been settled on the basis of compromise. The parties are bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise. However, this Court cannot pass a decree on the basis of said compromise. The compromise deed will be presented before the respective courts where the litigation is pending.”

In view of the above and the compromise arrived at between the parties, the instant compromise application is allowed. Consequently, this petition, along with all pending applications, stands disposed of in terms of the compromise, to the extent of the properties forming subject matter of the present petition. It is, however, clarified that the compromise shall bind only the signatories thereto and shall not affect the rights or interests of any person who is not a party/signatory to the compromise. Nothing stated herein shall be

construed as an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the respective claims of the parties.

Suit No.783 of 2020, which is presently connected with this petition, is hereby de-tagged. Constitution Petition bearing No.741 of 2023 is adjourned to **15.09.2026**.
