ORDER

Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J. Petitioner Shirin Khan has filed this Constitutional Petition under Article 199 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, with the following prayer: -

- “a. Declare the action of Respondent No.2 NADRA in blocking/suspending the CNIC of the Petitioner as illegal, unlawful, arbitrary and without lawful authority.*
- b. Direct the Respondents to immediately restore/unblock the CNIC of the Petitioners*
- c. Direct Respondent No.2-NADRA to update and maintain the Petitioner' records in accordance with law and D-Blocking the CNIC of Petitioner immediately.*
- d. To direct the Respondent not to create the harassment and coercive action against the petitioners till the disposal of this Petition*

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of NADRA submits that CNIC of the Petitioner is digitally impounded as family of individuals matched with IFRP as per letter dated 20.02.2026. He also submits that Petitioner did not approach to any verification board for CNIC clearance, therefore, the Petitioner may be advised to appear at concerned zonal office along with all documents in original prior to 1979, 1x Alpha family member for evaluation of the case as per revised verification and revocation policy 5.0.0.

3. When confronted this position of the case, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that he is ready and willing to approach concerned zonal office of NADRA along with all documents for evaluation of his case as per verification and revocation policy.

4. In view of above, by consent of the parties, the instant petition along with pending application stands disposed of in the above terms with the directions to NADRA that in case the case of the Petitioner is found genuine, the same shall be proceeded and such exercise shall be completed within a period of two weeks.
