Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J. The petitioner, Suriya Bibi, has filed this Constitutional Petition under Article 199 of the Constitution seeking release of her pensionary and retirement benefits.

2. Petitioner was appointed as Sanitary Worker (BPS-02) on 10.11.1982 and retired from service on 30.03.2023; however, her pensionary dues remained unpaid.

3. Learned Counsel for KMC, through letter dated 13.08.2026, submitted that the petitioner's pension claim amounting to Rs. 2,415,171/- had been received by KMC and that the outstanding pensionary dues would be released within six weeks. It was further submitted that KMC is arranging funds from the Provincial Government for clearance of pensionary dues of retired TMC employees in compliance with the directions of this Court.

4. Learned Counsel for the petitioner expressed satisfaction with the statement made on behalf of KMC.

5. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for KMC that the petitioner's pensionary claim amounting to Rs. 2,415,171/- has been received by KMC and that the outstanding pensionary dues shall be released within six weeks, coupled with the fact that the learned counsel for the petitioner is satisfied with the said statement, the instant petition is disposed of accordingly. However, the KMC shall ensure release of the petitioner's admissible pensionary/retirement benefits within the stipulated period, strictly in accordance with law.

6. In case of non-compliance, the petitioner shall be at liberty to seek appropriate remedy in accordance with law.

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
