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**ORDER**

**Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J.** Petitioner has filed the instant Constitutional Petition under Article 199 of the Constitution, seeking issuance of his CNIC without further delay.

2. Learned counsel for NADRA submitted that the Petitioner’s application for a fresh CNIC, filed on 24.10.2022, had been referred to the Zonal Board for verification and was subsequently cleared in the DLC meeting held on 24.07.2025 on the basis of the supporting documents. NADRA’s counsel accordingly submitted that the Petitioner may approach the nearest NADRA Centre for reprocessing of his CNIC in accordance with law and policy.
3. In view of the statement, learned counsel for the Petitioner expressed satisfaction and agreed to approach the nearest NADRA Centre.
4. Accordingly, with the consent of the parties, the petition is disposed of with the direction that the requisite process for issuance of the CNIC be completed within two weeks.
