ORDER

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MUHAMMAD IQBAL KALHORO J: Applicant was arrested on spy information by a police team of P.S. Gadap City Karachi headed by SIP Habibulah from Chanai Road, Peral Mari Hotel, Gadap City alongwith co-accused Zain Abdeen @ Abideen and Nadeem. From all three arrested accused separate quantity of Charas was recovered. From applicant 1040 grams of Charas was recovered, hence they were booked in FIR bearing Cr. No.422/2026 U/s 9(1) 3(c), CNS Act, 2024 of P.S. Gadap City, Karachi.

2. Learned counsel in defence has pleaded for bail on the grounds that applicant is first offender; alleged offence does not fall within prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C; co-accused have already been granted bail by this court; investigation is over and applicant is no more required for further investigation.

3. On the other hand, learned Addl.P.G. has opposed bail.

4. We have considered submissions of the parties and are of the view that the applicant is entitled to bail as he is the first offender, investigation is already complete and his incarceration in jail is not beneficial in any way to the prosecution and co-accused have been granted bail. Even otherwise, the alleged offence does not fall within prohibitory clause u/s 497 Cr.P.C. and there is prima facie no evidence of videography of the incident in compliance of section 17(2), Sindh CNS Act, 2024. In these facts and circumstances, we allow this application and grant bail to the applicant subject to his furnishing a solvent surety in the sum of Rs.200,000/- and P.R bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial court.

The observations made hereinabove are tentative in nature and would not prejudice case of either party at trial.

The Cr. Bail Applications are disposed of.
