- 2-4. All three Petitioners claim to be residents of the same Apartment Building and are aggrieved by the actions of the Respondents Nos.6 to 8, who are private individuals, inasmuch as it is stated that they are posing as Office Bearers of a fictitious/unregistered Association portrayed as managing the affairs of such Building, and are thus collecting sums from the residents on account of maintenance charges etc., whilst also hindering the Petitioners’ right of access. It is said that a complaint has been made to the Social Welfare Department, which has in turn referred the matter to the concerned police functionaries, but no definite action has been taken. It is sought that directions be issued by this Court in that regard.

Having considered the matter, we are of the view that the dispute is one between the Petitioners and the Respondents Nos.6 to 8 and if any illegal acts committed by them constitute an offence so as to warrant action by the Police, the Petitioners may come forward for the purpose of registering an FIR, and, if necessary, invoke jurisdiction of the concerned Justice of Peace for obtaining such

directions as may be deemed appropriate from the standpoint of the Police. Recourse to Article 199 of the Constitution appears to be misconceived. The Petition is found to be misconceived and accordingly stands dismissed *in limine*, along with the other Miscellaneous Applications.
