Through this petition, the petitioner has prayed that respondent Nos.2 and 3 be directed to issue Sale Certificate in favour of the petitioner in respect of property bearing C.S.No.2189/3, measuring 622-2 square yards situated at Karbala Road, Rohri. Pursuant to the notices Respondents have filed their comments.

Perusal of the comments reflects that on the application of respondent No.6, an enquiry in respect of same property has been initiated against the petitioner. However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since long the petitioner has been dragged in so-called enquiries under one or the other pretext.

Be that as it may, in these proceedings we cannot resolve factual controversy with regard to the authenticity of documents or entitlement of the petitioner or any body else, therefore, we while dismissing this petition, direct ACE authorities to complete enquiry within 2 weeks under
